

FIRE PROTECTION IN THE HOTEL

Dear Guest,

Hereafter you will find all the necessary information in order to prevent fire in the Hotel and to ensure that in the event of an emergency, you will feel safe in our hotel.

TO PREVENT A FIRE

- . Please do not throw any burning cigarettes or matches into the trash can.
- . Do not lay any clothing on lamps or other electrical appliances.
- . Do not overload the electrical outlets with multiple appliances at the same time.

SAFETY MEASURES

. Be familiar with the escape routes. Look at the map located on the back of the main room's door.

- . Walk along the hallway and take notice of where the emergency exits are located.
- . Notice details, i.e. the number of doors between your room and the emergency exit.
- . Look for and remember the location of the nearest fire alarm and fire extinguisher.
- . Be familiar with your hotel room.
- . Always keep your room keycard in the same location.
- . Check the windows.

HOW TO REACT IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE EMERGENCY

- .- Leave your room Check if your door and the hallway are safe escape routes.
- .- Bring to safety
 Warn others who are endangered.

Only use the marked escape routes.

Do not use the elevators!

Pay attention to warning and alarm signals.

FIRE PROTECTION IN THE HOTEL

- .- Report the fire

 Activate the nearest fire alarm or inform the reception desk, Ext. 6999.
- .- Attempt to extinguish

 Fire extinguishers and hoses are located in the marked cabinet in the hallways and exits.
- .- If the hallway is inaccessible Inform the reception desk or a member of our staff.

Fill the bathtub with water (to extinguish the fire).

Wet towels and sheets.

If the room fills with smoke open the window.

For your own safety, do not open the window when smoke is rising up from below.

If you have carefully read this information, you will be well prepared in the event of an emergency. Of course, we hope that you will never need to use it. We wish you a pleasant and safe stay in our Hotel. Thank you.
